### ***Discrimination Themes Explored***

Social studies students had a chance to study the rise and fall of the fish canning industry when they visited the Georgia Cannery in Steveston. In an interactive way, they learned how various ethnic groups were involved in the canning of salmon, and how, at its decline, the industry shifted to herring reduction. Students learned of the discriminatory treatment towards front line workers, particularly the Chinese, Japanese and Aborigines. Themes of discrimination were also investigated by the grades 11 & 12 classes who visited the Holocaust Education Centre to study Canadian and Jewish participation in the 1936 Olympics in Nazi Germany. How blessed we are to worship a God of inclusion.
